02 A catastrophic world record..

03 A Young Brazilian man survives with a bullet lodged in his brain for 4 days!

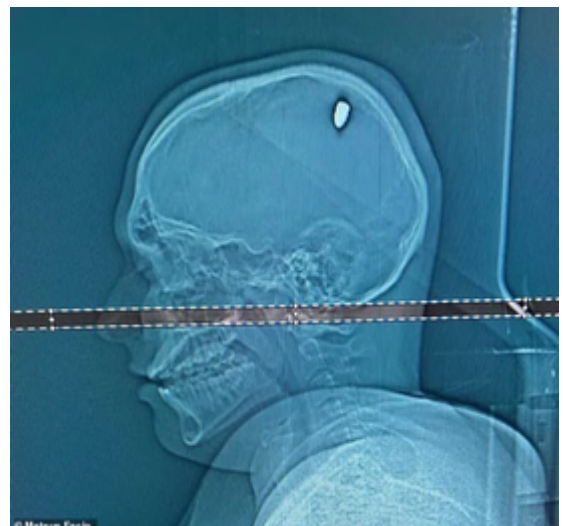

A Brazilian student continued to party for four days without realising he had been shot in the head, leaving a 9 mm bullet lodged in his brain.

Mateus Facio, 21, thought he had been hit in the head by someone throwing a rock while he was partying on New Year's Eve in Rio de Janeiro and didn't think anything of it after the bleeding stopped quickly.

Facio spent the following four days partying with friends and swimming in the ocean - totally ignorant of the fact he had been shot.

Facio underwent a two-hour life-saving operation and spent two days in intensive care, with the university student now recovering at his home in Juiz de Fora, southern Brazil

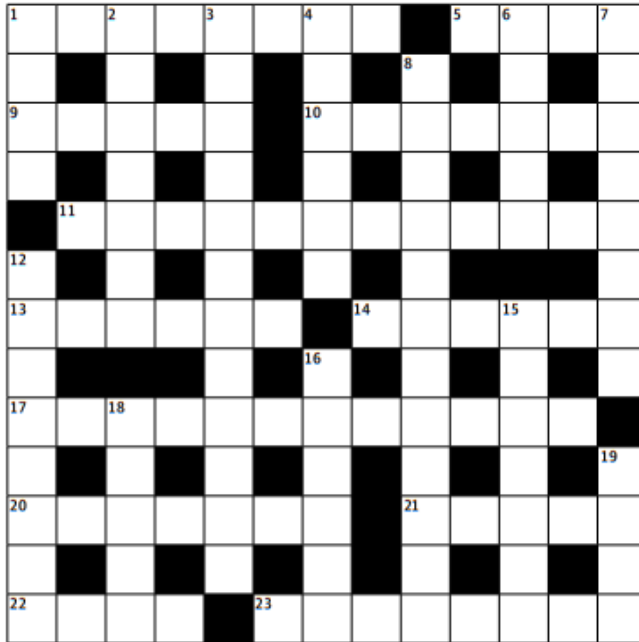

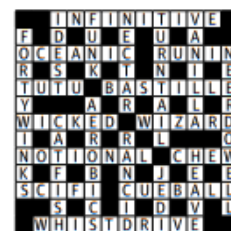
